Routes

Below you will find information for the following journeys:

1. London King's Cross Station to Edinburgh Waverley
2. Edinburgh Waverley to London King's Cross Station

Our trains are powered by electricity so you may find them much quieter than a diesel train.

Time

Each train journey will take a different time, depending on which station you are using.

Tunnels

On certain routes, the train will go through tunnels. Tunnels can seem very dark when you go through them but the lights inside your carriage will always be on.



Some tunnels take hardly any time to go through, whilst others take a little longer. To help you plan your journey and recognise where a train may go through a tunnel, the following information is provided to help you.

King’s Cross Station to Edinburgh Waverley Route

The following information tells you how long it should take on the train, between each station:

Other useful information

The two different tunnels are on the Hertford loop. This is a branch of the East Coast Main Line, part of the Northern City Line commuter route to London:
